Conference Poster Session Requirements for All Participants

- You must register for the conference by Thursday, March 16th at 5:00 pm
- Posters can be no larger than 3'x4' vertically (width 3')

th Annual Bay Area

- We will provide the easels, but you are expected to provide your own poster board.
- At least 1 presenter is expected to be at the poster during breaks, lunch, and at the afternoon poster session
- You must check in with the poster session coordinator upon arrival. They will give you instructions on where to set up your poster.
- The Morning Break occurs at 10:00 am, and it is expected that your poster is set up by then.

Tips and Guidelines When Making a Poster

- Keep your poster short. Your audience should be able to finish reading your poster in 5-10 minutes
- There should be an abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results, conclusion, references, and acknowledgements
- Have a clear and concise title, and format it as a sentence
- Avoid paragraphs and use bullet-points
- Use images, graphs, and tables instead of words. They are more visually pleasing and better convey your message
- Avoid a dark background as it makes your poster harder to read. A white background is preferable.
